OUR IMPACT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY

The Literacy Coalition of Palm Beach County is dedicated to ensuring that individuals receive the help they need to develop or improve their literacy skills. Annually, we provide services to 55,716 adults, teens, children and families through nine programs at 173 sites from Jupiter to Boca Raton to Belle Glade. We provide literacy instruction in family education programs and at workplace or community sites. Our Literacy

AmeriCorps members teach, tutor, mentor and provide homework help in libraries, schools and nonprofit agencies. Our work with children includes collaborating with pediatricians who advise parents about the importance of reading with their children. We recruit, train and support volunteers who tutor children that are struggling readers and we teach literature-based, activity-driven curriculums in afterschool programs and summer camps.
